LAS VEGAS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT CONTRACT NO. C1198 MULTI-SITE SURGE TANK UPGRADE

PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT NO. CL-2008-293

PROJECT SCOPE: The Work Sites are located at the following Las Vegas Valley Water District facilities: 1) Grand Canyon 2860 and 2975 Zone Pumping Stations, 3315 N. Grand Canyon Drive, Las Vegas, 89129, 2) Rice 2538 and 2635 Zone Pumping Stations, 6930 W. Oakey Boulevard, Las Vegas, 89117, 3) Ronzone 2420 Zone Pumping Station, 6415 W. Lake Mead Boulevard, Las Vegas, 89108, and 4) Underhill 2745 Zone Pumping Station, 7800 W. Charleston Boulevard, Las Vegas, 89117. The Work consists of modification work to the surge tanks at the Grand Canyon, Rice, Ronzone, and Underhill Pumping Station Sites. These modifications will upgrade the eight existing surge tanks to operate using automatic level control systems. Work includes: installing compressed air systems for each surge tank, providing an additional surge tank at the Grand Canyon 2975 Zone Pumping Station, site work, and associated electrical and instrumentation work, as required, and other ancillary work as required by the Contract Documents.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Copies of the Bidding Documents consisting of the contract documents, specifications, and reduced drawings together with a set of full-size drawings may be obtained at the Purchasing Office of the Las Vegas Valley Water District (District), (702) 258-3200, for the non-refundable cost of \$50.00. Please call to make sure the bid documents are available before visiting the District to purchase them. If documents are to be mailed, bidders may have the mailing expedited by providing with their check the name of the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If not specified, the documents shall be mailed via United Parcel Service ground with a non-refundable charge of \$20.00. Checks must be received at the above-mentioned office and shall be payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District."

Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Documents Volume, and the complete Contract Documents Volume shall be submitted to comprise a responsive and responsible bid. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of not less than ten percent of the amount named in the proposal.
