PROJECT SCOPE: The project Site is located 1.5 miles east of Interstate Highway I-15 and approximately 0.5 miles east of the State of Nevada Prison facility in Jean, Nevada and is within Clark County jurisdiction. The Site can be accessed via the existing 30-foot wide dirt road at the north end of the State of Nevada Prison Facility. The prison is located about one mile east of Las Vegas Boulevard at the end of Prison Road. This project consists of the construction of items presented in two alternate bid schedules: Bid Schedule A and Bid Schedule B. Bidders may bid both Bid Schedules A and B or may bid either Bid Schedule A or B. The District shall award the contract based on either Bid Schedule A or B, at the District's option. Bid Schedule A consists of the construction of a new 600,000 gallon above-ground bolted steel tank with associated appurtenances; temporary and permanent yard piping; demolition of existing yard piping, excavation and backfill of tank pad; ringwall foundation; necessary site preparation; electrical and instrumentation improvements; refurbishment of the interior coatings of the existing one million-gallon welded steel tank, cathodic protection system for the existing one million-gallon welded steel tank; refurbishment of the interior coatings of the existing 0.4 million gallon welded steel tank, and cathodic protection system for the existing 0.4 million-gallon welded steel tank. Bid Schedule B consists of the construction of a new 600,000 gallon above-ground welded steel tank with associated appurtenances; temporary and permanent yard piping; demolition of existing yard piping, excavation and backfill of tank pad; ringwall foundation; cathodic protection system; necessary site preparation; electrical and instrumentation improvements; refurbishment of the interior coatings of the existing one million-gallon welded steel tank, cathodic protection system for the existing one million-gallon welded steel tank; refurbishment of the interior coatings of the existing 0.4 million-gallon welded steel tank, and cathodic protection system for the existing 0.4 million-gallon welded steel tank. Additive/Deductive Bid Items include demolition of the existing 62,500 gallon welded steel tank including abatement and disposal of existing lead based paint; refurbishment of the exterior of the existing one million gallon welded steel tank reservoir, including abatement and disposal of existing lead based paint; refurbishment of the exterior of the existing 0.4 million gallon welded steel tank, including abatement and disposal of existing lead based paint.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Copies of the Bidding Documents consisting of the contract documents, specifications, and reduced drawings together with a set of full-size drawings may be obtained at the Purchasing Office of the Las Vegas Valley Water District (District), (702) 258-3200, for the non-refundable cost of \$50.00. Please call to make sure the bid documents are available before visiting the District to purchase them. If documents are to be mailed, bidders may have the mailing expedited by providing with their check the name of the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If not specified, the documents shall be mailed via United Parcel Service ground with a non-refundable charge of \$20.00. Checks must be received at the above-mentioned office and shall be payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District."

Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Documents Volume, and the complete Contract Documents Volume shall be submitted to comprise a responsive and responsible bid. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of not less than ten percent of the amount named in the proposal.
