**PROJECT SCOPE:** The Sites of the Work are the Reno 2745 Zone Reservoir (Reno Reservoir Site) and Warm Springs 2420 Zone South Reservoir (Warm Springs Reservoir Site). The Reno Reservoir Site is located along Hualapai Way, south of Tropicana Avenue. The Warm Springs Reservoir Site is located at the intersection of Jones Boulevard and Warm Springs Road. Both sites are located on District property and within dedicated Clark County rights-of-way. The work at the Reno Reservoir Site consists of constructing a meandering sidewalk and installing landscaping to match the existing sidewalk and landscaping north and south of the site along Hualapai Way. The work also includes constructing a sewer lateral to connect the existing on-site 6 inch sewer pipeline to the existing 8 inch sewer pipeline in Ritornia Avenue, located just north of the site within the Siena Community. The work at the Warm Springs Reservoir Site consists of constructing half-street improvements to Warm Springs Road. These improvements include constructing new pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, utility lid adjustments, streetlights, landscaping, and grading along the south of the Warm Springs Reservoir Site and the Southern Nevada Water Authority Warm Springs Rate of Flow Control Station.

If not specified, the documents shall be mailed via United Parcel Service ground with a non-refundable charge of \$20.00. Checks must be received at the above-mentioned office and shall be payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District."

Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Documents Volume, and the complete Contract Documents Volume shall be submitted to comprise a responsive and responsible bid. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of not less than ten percent of the amount named in the proposal.
