KYLE CANYON SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS - LOWER RAINBOW

PROJECT SCOPE: The Sites of the Work are located in the Lower Rainbow Subdivision in Kyle Canyon, Nevada, within Clark County rights-of-way and dedicated easements, in the following generally described areas: 1) Moritz Way from Alpine Way to Mont Blanc Way, 2) Mont Blanc Way from Moritz Way to Ski Trail Road, 3) Arlberg Way from Mont Blanc to Alpine Way, 4) Alpine Way from Mont Blanc Way to Rainbow Canyon Boulevard, 5) Ski Trail Road from Davos Way to Rainbow Canyon Boulevard, 6) Davos Way from Ski Trail Road to Rainbow Canyon Boulevard, and 7) Rainbow Canyon Boulevard from 205 Rainbow Canyon Boulevard to Alpine Way. Potential Sites of the Work, based on Additive Bid Items, are: 1) Arlberg Way cul-de-sac, 2) Alpine Way cul-de-sac, 3) Summit View Circle cul-de-sac, 4) Ski Trail Road cul-de-sac, 5) Canyon Circle cul-de-sac, 6) Davos Way cul-de-sac, and 7) Shady Circle cul-de-sac. The Work consists of the abandonment of existing 2 and 4 inch diameter pipe; installation of approximately 4,020 horizontal linear feet of 8 inch inside diameter Class 150 DR18 polyvinyl chloride pressure pipe; installation of approximately 2,520 horizontal linear feet of 6 inch inside diameter Class 150 DR18 polyvinyl chloride pressure pipe; installation of 71 new water service assemblies; reconnection of 16 water service assemblies; installation of 19 new water service assemblies along existing pipeline locations; abandonment of eight fire hydrants; installation of 11 new fire hydrant assemblies; placement of temporary trench patch in Lower Rainbow subdivision; removal of existing and placement of new street width permanent pavement in Lower Rainbow and Upper Rainbow subdivisions; and all related valves, fittings, connections and appurtenances. The Work associated with the cul-de-sacs listed above will be bid as Additive Bid Items and includes the installation of up to approximately 920 linear feet of 6 inch inside diameter Class 150 DR18 polyvinyl chloride pressure pipe; installation of new water service assemblies; reconnection of existing water service assemblies; installation of new water service assemblies along existing pipeline locations; placement of temporary trench patch, removal of existing and placement of new street width permanent pavement in affected streets; and all related valves, fittings, connections and appurtenances.

If documents are to be mailed, bidders may have the mailing expedited by providing with their check the name of the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If not specified, the documents shall be mailed via United Parcel Service ground with a non-refundable charge of \$20.00. Checks must be received at the above-mentioned office and shall be payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District."

Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Documents Volume, and the complete Contract Documents Volume shall be submitted to comprise a responsive and responsible bid. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of not less than ten percent of the amount named in the proposal.
