LAS VEGAS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT CONTRACT NO. C1279 HARD ROCK PRESSURE ZONE CONVERSION

PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT NO. CL-2009-104

PROJECT SCOPE: Three Sites of the Work are located within Clark County or Nevada Department of Transportation rights-of-way at the intersections of Harmon Avenue and Swenson Street; Paradise Road and Naples Drive; and Paradise Road and Tropicana Avenue. Fifteen additional sites are located at the following addresses on Paradise Road: 4165, 4211, 4255, 4200, 4455, 4300, 4350, 4416, 4475, 4480, 4501, 4505, 4510, 4520, and 4633. The Work consists of converting the existing 12 inch diameter asbestos cement pipe (ACP) in Paradise Road, extending from Flamingo Road to Tropicana Avenue, from the District's 2168 Pressure Zone to the 2300 Pressure Zone. This pressure zone conversion will be accomplished by disconnecting the existing 12 inch diameter ACP pipe from the 2168 pressure zone and reconnecting to existing 2300 pressure zone piping. Twenty seven water meters at the above listed addresses are to have backflow devices (as necessary) and pressure reducing valves installed prior to the pressure zone conversion.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Copies of the Bidding Documents consisting of the contract documents, specifications, and reduced drawings together with a set of full-size drawings may be obtained at the Purchasing Office of the Las Vegas Valley Water District (District), (702) 258-3200, for the non-refundable cost of \$25.00. Please call to make sure the bid documents are available before visiting the District to purchase them. If documents are to be mailed, bidders may have the mailing expedited by providing with their check the name of the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If not specified, the documents shall be mailed via United Parcel Service ground with a non-refundable charge of \$20.00. Checks must be received at the above-mentioned office and shall be payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District."

Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Documents Volume, and the complete Contract Documents Volume shall be submitted to comprise a responsive and responsible bid. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of not less than ten percent of the amount named in the proposal.
